

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL INFORMATION

Hours - Doors at the elementary school open at 7:55 a.m. for students eating breakfast. Parents are asked not to send their child to school before that time. No supervision is provided until 8:00 a.m. The tardy bell rings at 8:25 a.m. Students must be in their classrooms by that time. Dismissal time will be 3:18 p.m. for grades K-2 and 3:21 p.m. for grades 3-4.

The 4K Program is located at the Elementary School. The A.M. session is from 8 to 11 a.m. and the P.M. session is from 12:15 to 3:15 p.m.

First Day - Class lists will be posted on room doors and school personnel will assist students who need help finding their classrooms.

Bicycles - Students can ride their bikes to school. Racks are provided and youngsters must use them. Bikes should be locked. The school assumes no responsibility for stolen or damaged property. Children are encouraged to wear safety helmets while riding their bicycles.

Parent Transportation - Parents should drop children off and pick them up in front of school ONLY! PLEASE STAY OUT OF THE YELLOW CURB AREA! School buses load and unload behind the school. This is a bus zone only!

Students walking to school from areas behind and east of the building should walk on the sidewalk on Water Street, cross at the bakery corner, and enter school through the front door.

School crossing guards are on duty starting at 7:55 to 8:20 a.m. and from 3:10 to 3:30 p.m.

Meal/Milk Deposits - Parents are encouraged to make deposits into their PowerLunch accounts before the start of school. Deposits can be made at any school office anytime or through e-Funds on our website.

MIDDLE SCHOOL INFORMATION

Hours - The Commons is open at 7:40 a.m. for students. School begins at 8:20 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. Students should not be at school before 7:40 a.m. or after 3:45 p.m. unless they are attending a supervised activity.

First Day - All students should go to their assigned class at 8:15 a.m. Class lists are posted in school for each grade level. School personnel will assist students.

Bikers-Walkers - Use traffic safety practices. Bicycles should be secured in the bike rack that is provided. Students are responsible for locking their bikes.

Parent Transportation - Parents should drop off students in the upper parking lot or on Eighth Avenue next to the school sidewalk. Vehicles should not be in the bus loading area behind the middle school in the morning or evening during bus hours.

Meal/Milk Deposits - Parents are encouraged to make deposits into their PowerLunch accounts before the start of school. Deposits can be made at any school office anytime or through e-Funds on our website.

Closed Campus - Students are not allowed to leave the school grounds during the school day without the school receiving permission from a parent. The student must sign out in the office.

Student/Parent Handbook - Our handbook is available online and hard copies are available upon request. Please read the handbook with your child. Contact the school office or your child's teacher if you have questions or concerns at any time (822-5122).

School Sponsored Athletics - Physicals are required for all middle school sports.



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HIGH SCHOOL INFORMATION

First Day - Tuesday, September 4 is the first day of school for all high school students. All students (freshmen through seniors) are to report to the gym at 8:20 a.m. on September 4.

Class Dues - Class dues are a one-time fee of \$5.00, due at the beginning of a student's freshman year. Class dues are to help pay for class expenses such as senior banquet, graduation, etc.

Noon Hour Policy - There will be a closed campus during the noon hour for 9th, 10th and 11th grade students - 12th grade students may leave with parental permission. Seniors will receive the parent permission slip during the first week of school. This form must be completed and returned to the high school office if you wish to allow your senior student to leave the campus during noon hour. Eligibility for open campus for seniors will include evaluating the student's attendance and discipline records. Open campus for seniors will begin Monday, September 10; they will be expected to stay on campus during lunch tracks until that date.
