

**CUMBERLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT
TECHNOLOGY ACCEPTABLE USE AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS**

Introduction:

Each user will be held responsible for their actions and network/electronic identity while using the technology tools provided by the District. The use of these tools is a privilege, not a right. These privileges can and will be revoked if the privileges are abused. Upon abuse of these privileges and policies, the District reserves the right to pursue school disciplinary and/or legal action.

In order to use the technology tools made available in the District, each user (staff and student) must have a current signed Technology Acceptable Use Agreement on file with their respective building level office.

Unacceptable/Improper Use:

Unacceptable usage of school district resources and accounts include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Physical damage/modification/theft of equipment or property
- Disruption of network activity, resources, and bandwidth
- Access to, storage of, and/or distribution of illegal, sexually explicit, or otherwise questionable material
- Downloading/distribution of viruses or otherwise unapproved software
- Using excessive amounts of consumable resources
- Engaging in illegal acts or violating any local, state, or federal statutes or laws
- Disruption/denial of educational access to others
- Accessing another user's account/information
- Plagiarism and/or copyright violations
- Failure to report observed violations of the Acceptable Use Policy

Consequences:

Improper use, accidental misuse, and/or intentional misuse of District property can and will be punished as deemed suitable by the District. If the Acceptable Use Policy is not followed, it will be grounds for revocation of privileges, restitution, expulsion, and/or criminal sanctions under Wisconsin Statute 947.0125. Statute 947.0125 covers threatening, intimidating, abusive or harassing messages sent to another person through electronic mail or other computerized systems.

The Cumberland School District reserves the right to recover the cost of any and/or all losses that result from misuse.
