OUR PROJECT

STARLAB is the first project selected by the Cumberland Educational Foundation. The portable STARLAB was purchased with a \$15,000 Cumberland Educational Foundation Legacy Grant. This STARLAB curriculum will allow students in grades K-12 increased involvement in subject areas such as science, math, language arts, and social studies. The projection cylinders are the secret to the versatility of STARLAB. Constant development of new cylinders, in a wide variety of disciplines, may be added to the system at any time. Currently, the lab is equipped with cylinders that allow students to observe the star field and constellations.
