Dear Parents:

A case of Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye) is in your child's grade. This is highly contagious and spreads easily and quickly from person to person. Symptoms to watch for include:

- \*redness/swelling of the white of the eye or under the eyelid
- \*increased tearing
- \*white, yellow or green eye drainage
- \*light sensitivity
- \* crusting on the eyelid or lashes
- \*gritty feeling in the eye

If your child develops any of these symptoms, keep your child home and contact your healthcare provider. Your child may return to school 24 hours after treatment is started, if indicated by your healthcare provider. Make sure to wash hands frequently and avoid touching the eyes.
