TOTAL REFERENDUM COST: \$32,950,000

Renovate the West Wing

Renovations to create science labs and an updated media center.

\$3,944,000

Construct a Secure Entrance and Improve Parking Lot Safety

New secure entrance, parent and bus drop off areas, expanded parking, and High School central services

\$4,824,000

Expand Commons and Cafeteria/Food Service Space

Expanded commons, new cafeteria, improved food service area and delivery access.

\$2,778,000

Removal of the 1960s Two-Story Wing

Replace the Outdated and Failing 1960s Two-Story with New Academic Addition

Demolition of existing two-story wing, tying new academic addition into existing structure, building new replacement classrooms and flexible learning space.

Expand the Wrestling Room

Repurpose and expand existing room to create multi-use practice space.
